«Bright dark pink with an orange tinge. Perfumed nose of ripe peach, honey and vanilla; this smells as if the grapes were superripe or partially hit by noble rot. Then juicy, bright and dense, with suave redcurrant and fresh citrus flavors that are multilayered and complex. Long and creamy on the precise, delicious aftertaste. Much fruitier than in past vintages, this is a knockout Franciacorta Rosé, the best I have ever tasted from Villa Crespia. A Chardonnay and Pinot noir blend.»
